Overall, for the year 2011, Athens International Airport's number of flights amounted to 173 thousands, experiencing an overall decline of 9.6% compared to the corresponding period of 2010. This traffic loss is mainly due to the country's financial and economic recession and the continuing rationalisation of the Greek carriers' network, reflected in the double-digit decline of domestic services (-14.4%), with the international movements presenting a significantly more limited decline (-5.2%).
